


The Inca civilization

- . Sweet potatoes


And many other vegetables and other plants.

- In the 13-16 century, the Inca people's diet was mostly made up of grains and roots in the such as potato, okas, maize and some times llama.




What did the Inca royal family eat?

- The Inca royal food was similar to the Aztecs, but also included quinoa, potatoes, llama, alpaca, guinea pig, deer and insects.
- But frogs, mushrooms, fish, and exotic fruits were eaten by exclusively by Inca royalty.



Incan gods

- The god of Incan Mythology was the creator of Virococha who was both the god who created the world and also a man who travelled the earth doing great deeds.
- The sun god Inti was the god of agriculture. Inti was represented as a golden disk with rays and a human face in the centre.
- The moon, Mamaquilla was a goddess and a wife of the sun. She wasn't worshipped very much but was a important part of Incan mythology.



What weapons did the Incas use?

- The Inca weapons used by the Inca Empire during their battles with other native communities or with Spanish Conquistadors could be particularly brutal. Here are some weapons they used:
- Waraka. The waraka was a form of slingshot.
- Macana. The macana was used in the same way as a mace.
- Ayllu. The ayllu was a sack of stones attached to a piece of rope.




When was Machu Pichu founded?

The structure is located about 2430 meters above sea level and about 80 kilometres away from the city of Cusco. The ancient Inca city is considered a master piece because of its incredible design.
