School Self Evaluation (S.S.E.) The area of focus this year is Writing, a strand of the New Primary Language Curriculum - English. We hope you will work on this at home with your son. More details will follow.

Uniform: Please ensure your son wears the correct uniform (including black shoes) on non P.E. days and that all items of the uniform have his name clearly marked on them. Runners may be worn by all pupils each Friday. Uniform Crests are available in the office. The cost of the Crest is  $\leq 6$ , available from school office.

Book Rental - Please note: your son has been allocated an identification number which is on all the books he will rent this year. These books will be returned to the school in June 2023. Parents/Guardians will be asked to purchase new books if those rented are lost or damaged.

**Traffic:** Our school is situated on a very narrow road! To avoid traffic congestion, we politely request that cars down St Patrick's Road from the main street when approaching the school, rather than coming up from Carysfort Road. We also request that you remain mindful of our neighbours at school drop off and pickup times, and do not block the pedestrian crossing or any entrances. We thank our lollipop lady, Joan Fox, for ensuring that the children from both our school and Loreto cross safely every day.
